 healthy as possible. It's your turn to protect them from here on out and giving them health

 - Small space is good habits! Have your bathroom, spare bedroom, or dog crate set up as your kittenz home for the next couple days to one week. Litter box, scooper, food/water bowl, toys, bed... that's all they'll need.
 - Your kitten should be confined to a small space in order for it to acclimate to its new environment. They are experiencing a lot of new smells, new faces, and new everything! This is the beginning of the rest of your life together. Better to keep on the path of development and instill proper litter box habits now. The more space your kitten has to explore the more likely a piddle accident is bound to happen. We recommend scooping the litter box in the AM and PM... and anytime you use the bathroom because how hard is it to give the litter box an extra scoop? Your nose will thank you and also kittenz don't like to use smelly bathrooms either.
 - Better kitty proof the shit out of your house! That means covering exposed wires (yes, they do chew them! So, wipe tobasco sauce on them), secure your prized crystal award that you received for employee of the month, tuck up those curtain cords death trap, and pick up your kids crap off the floor like rubber bands, and ALWAYS DO A HEAD COUNT! These monkeys will climb, crawl, jump, end up in your refrigerator, dishwasher, washer/dryer and in cabinets! Wouldn't want to wash your new \$2,000 pussycat with your clothes, so please just check.

2. SNOOPY, TOM, AND JERRY

We love our pets and we know you do too! So please, please, please, if other pets are involved we strongly advise you keep everyone in separate living quarters for at least one week.

- A. Why one week? Because this isn't our first rodeo, silly!
 - Scent. Territory. Higher Archie. Ah, the joy of telling Snoopy, Tom, and Jerry they have a new baby brother or sister! Sometimes the news doesn't go over so well and we understand this can be seen as no big deal, or it's a big challenge. It's safest for your new kitten to have an opportunity to learn the scent of the other animals in the home and vice versa.
 - Door stays closed between the two parties for about a week. Snoopy will woft the scent from
 under the door way and you can try moving the feeding dishes closer to the door each time.
 When it's finally time for visual interaction, Snoopy will see your kitten as less of a threat.
 Always provide supervision when they interact. If you feel most comfortable by putting the cat
 in a carrier when they first meet then do that. You are everyone's protector in case thing's go
 south.
 - Hissing is natural. But if anyone has aggression then you need to go back a step. Our kittens are raised with big dogs so they shouldn't have a problem with Snoop, but you never know.
 - Leash Snoop at first incase that tiny fur ball decides to act like a maniac. Hunting instincts may come out in even the calmest dog. Better safe than sorry.
 - We separate our animals when we are unable to supervise them.
 - Bye bye free feeding. Sorry, Snoop. You will thank me later when Snoopy doesn't eat Kitty for trying to eat from their bowl. And vice versa you don't want Snoop eating all of Kitties food.

3. IS THE DOCTOR IN?
